Repopulation Update

I. Repopulation Awareness

- Our responsibility is to make the area safe
- **Drive Slowly**, numerous crews and equipment will be working in and around the roadways
- Traffic and lane controls will be in effect
- Hazard Trees – Need to make sure all trees are safe especially along roadways
- We are doing everything we can to accommodate civilians and get people back into their homes as soon as possible.

II. Phase I, Wednesday, June 22, 2016

- The following Evacuation Order for greater Potrero community will be lifted at 4:00 PM with access for residents only. At 6:00 PM, access will be open to the general public. The following is the affected area where the evacuation order will be lifted; west of Potrero Valley Road at Potrero Valley, west of the General Store located at 25125 Highway 94, including both north and south sides of Highway 94. Also included is the Potrero County Park. Only residents affected within this area, with proper identification, will be allowed back in. All other Evacuation Orders and Warnings will remain in effect.

Road closures that will remain or are new:

- Highway 94 at Highway 188 will have a road closure to verify residence until 6:00PM
- Potrero Valley Road at Potrero Valley (new)
- Highway 94 just west of 25140 Highway 94.(new)
- Highway 94 west of Buckman Springs Road (existing)
- Buckman Springs Road at Old Buckman Springs (existing)

Safety Message

If there are electrical wires on the ground, stay clear and contact SDG&E immediately.

Trees and poles with deep charring, particularly if still smoking, should be considered hazardous.

Please drive slowly as emergency personnel are in the area.
